

HTACA Annual Conference Poster Presentation Requirements

Poster presenters must be on hand with their poster during the session. All presenters are required to include a statement disclosing any conflict of interest related to your abstract. This should be visible on your poster or poster board.

Poster size: (max) 4 feet high x 4 feet wide

Each poster must include text in a large enough font (~20 point font) to be read easily by attendees from a distance of 4 to 5 feet or more. Lettering on illustrations should be large and legible. Photographs should be a minimum of 5 x 7 inches.

Abstract submission deadline: **February 15, 2019**

Abstract format

Title

The abstract title should be brief, in capital letters, and should give a clear indication of the exact nature of the research and refer to the actual content of the abstract. Do not use abbreviations in the title.

Abstract

Please organize the abstract body as follows:

a. Objective (the aim of the study)

b. Methods

c. Results

d. Conclusions (Statements such as "the results will be discussed," or "data will be presented and discussed" are not acceptable.)

e. Keywords

DO NOT include references in your abstract

Maximum Characters: 4,000 (includes spaces)
